



A bad rule leads to this



How to use it?

CLEAR UP

(Remove all existing rules)

iptables -F

-F = FLUSH

POLICY

(The default policy to apply)

```
iptables -P INPUT -j DROP
```

-P = **POLICY** (INPUT, OUTPUT, FORWARD, ...)

-j = **JUMP** (ACCEPT, DROP, ...)

Example

```
iptables -A INPUT -s 1.1.1.1 -d 2.2.2.2 -j DROP
```


-A = APPEND (INPUT)

-s = SOURCE (1.1.1.1)

-d = TARGET (2.2.2.2)

-j = JUMP (DROP)
